Greetings:

This office and the Mateel Environmental Justice Foundation ("Mateel") give you notice that Nugget Market, Inc. ("Nugget") has been, is, and threatens to be in violation of Cal. Health & Safety Code § 25249.6. Both this office and Mateel are private enforcers of Proposition 65, both may be contacted at the below listed address and telephone number, and I am a responsible individual at both Mateel and this office. The above referenced violations occur when California residents ingest or otherwise come into contact with kombucha served on tap at supermarkets operated by Nugget. This kombucha is contaminated with lead, a chemical known to cause birth defects and other reproductive harm. When people ingest kombucha, they also ingest (and are therefore exposed to) lead. When people come into contact in other ways with kombucha -- such as when touching it -- some of the lead dissolved in the kombucha is absorbed through the skin, and enters through cuts and abrasions in the skin. The routes of exposure to lead from kombucha are therefore, via the ingestion, dermal absorption, subcutaneous, and mucous membrane routes of exposure. Nugget did not and does not provide people with clear and reasonable warnings before it exposes California residents to lead. These violations have occurred every day since at least July 6, 2014, and will continue every day until the lead is removed from the kombucha, or until clear and reasonable warnings are given. These violations are alleged for occupational and consumer product exposures. We do not allege occupational exposure violations as to kombucha manufactured outside of California. Workers who drink or come into contact with the kombucha on the Product List are exposed in the same way as consumers are -- by ingesting the kombucha or by touching it. This notice does not allege environmental exposure violations.

CERTIFICATE OF MERIT

I, William Verick, hereby declare: This Certificate of Merit accompanies the attached notice(s) of violation in which it is alleged the parties identified in the notices have violated Health and Safety Code section 25249.6 by failing to provide clear and reasonable warnings. I am the attorney for the noticing party. I have consulted with one or more persons with relevant and appropriate experience or expertise who has reviewed facts, studies, or other data regarding the exposure to the listed chemical that is the subject of the action. Based on the information obtained through those consultations, and on all other information in my possession, I believe there is a reasonable and meritorious case for the private action. I understand that "reasonable and meritorious case for the private action" means that the information provides a credible basis that all elements of the plaintiffs' case can be established and the information did not prove that the alleged violator will be able to establish any of the affirmative defenses set forth in the statute. The copy of this Certificate of Merit served on the Attorney General attaches to it factual information sufficient to establish the basis for this certificate, including the information identified in Health and Safety Code section 25249.7(h)(2), i.e., (1) the identity of the person(s) consulted with and relied on by the certifier, and (2) the facts, studies, or other plata-reviewed by those persons.

This notice alleges the violation of Proposition 65 with respect to occupational exposures governed by the California State Plan for Occupational Safety and Health. The State Plan incorporates the provisions of Proposition 65, as approved by Federal OSHA on June 6, 1997. This approval specifically placed certain conditions on Proposition 65, including that it does not apply to the conduct of manufacturers occurring outside the State of California. The approval also provides that an employer may use the means of compliances in the general hazard communication requirements to comply with Proposition 65. It also requires that supplemental enforcement is subject to the supervision of the California Occupational Safety and Health Administration. Accordingly, any settlement, civil complaint, or substantive court orders in this matter must be submitted to the Attorney General.
