**Re: 60-Day Notice Pursuant to Cal. Health & Safety Code § 25249.5, et seq.  
Violation of Proposition 65 Warning by COMPANY**

To The Procter & Gamble Co. ("P&G"), Mr. Bonta and Whomever Else it May Concern:

I represent Eileen Aviles, Shelby Cooper, Tanya Cooper and Jacob Cooper (the "Plaintiffs") in this matter and write on their behalf, pursuant to California's Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986 ("Proposition 65"), which is codified at California Health and Safety Code section 25249.5, *et seq.*, to notify you that P&G (the "Violator") violated Proposition 65 through its sale of Old Spice and Secret aerosol deodorants and antiperspirants. Plaintiffs are California citizens who purchased the products at issues in this notice and are acting in the interest of the general public to promote awareness of exposures to toxic chemicals in products sold in

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California and to improve human health by reducing hazardous substances contained in consumer products.

### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

For general information, please see “The Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986 (Proposition 65): A Summary” prepared by the California EPA and attached to this notice as Appendix A. (Appendix not included in notice served on public enforcement agencies.)

### **PURPOSE OF NOTICE**

Proposition 65 requires that notice of the alleged violation(s) and the intent to sue be given to the Violator at least 60 days before a Proposition 65 lawsuit is filed. This letter is sent pursuant to the provisions of Health & Safety Code § 25249.7 and satisfies the statutory notice prerequisite for filing an action in the Superior Court against the violator. This letter serves as a notice of these violations to the alleged Violator and the appropriate public enforcement agencies. Pursuant to section 25249.7(d) of the statute, Ms. Aviles, Ms. S. Cooper, Ms. T. Cooper and Mr. Cooper intend to file a private enforcement action in the public interest 60 days after effective service of this notice unless the public enforcement agencies have commenced and are diligently prosecuting an action to rectify these violations.

### **DESCRIPTION OF VIOLATION**

The violations alleged by this notice consist of types of harm that may potentially result from exposures to the toxic chemical benzene, which was listed as a known hazardous substance in February of 1987.

**Alleged Violator.** P&G violated Proposition 65 through its sale of aerosol deodorants and antiperspirants under its brands Old Spice and Secret.

**Consumer Product and Listed Chemical.** The Products that are the subject of this notice are:

- Old Spice Pure Sport Antiperspirant
- Old Spice Below Deck Powder Spray Deodorant
- Old Spice Sweat Defense Stronger Swagger Dry Spray Antiperspirant
- Secret Powder Fresh 24-Hour Aerosol antiperspirant
- Secret Cool Light & Airy Smooth Feel, Dry Spray Antiperspirant

These are collectively referred to as the “Products.” The Products contain benzene, a harmful carcinogen known to cause cancer in humans. (CAS No. 71-43-2). On February 27, 1987, the State of California officially listed benzene as a chemical known to cause cancer. Recent analysis from Valisure LLC, and independent consumer testing lab, demonstrates that each of the Products contain benzene levels that far exceed the FDA’s guidelines.

**Provision of Proposition 65.** This notice covers the “warning provision” of Proposition 65, which is found at California Health & Safety Code § 25249.6.

**Route of Exposure.** The National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health (NIOSH) designates benzene as a carcinogen and lists "inhalation, skin absorption, ingestion, skin and/or eye contact" as exposure routes. The consumer exposures that are the subject of this notice result from the purchase, acquisition, and recommended use of the Products, all of which are applied directly to the skin in the form of an aerosol mist. Consequently, the primary route of exposure is through dermal absorption and direct skin contact with the Products containing benzene. There is a further risk of benzene exposure through ingestion and inhalation because the aerosol spray Products are applied in close proximity to consumers' the mouths and noses.

**Violations.** The Violator has exposed and continues to expose consumers within the State of California to benzene at levels that, upon reasonable use of the Products, exceed the No Significant Risk Level and the Maximum Allowable Dose Level without providing a clear and reasonable warning of this exposure. In particular, the Violator fails to warn consumers that the Products contain benzene -- a chemical known to the State of California to cause cancer.


**Approximate Time Period of Violations.** Ongoing violations have occurred every day since 2017 or earlier, as well as every day since the Products were introduced into the California marketplace and will continue every day until clear and reasonable warnings are provided to the Products' purchasers or until these known toxic chemicals are either removed from or reduced to allowable levels in the Products. Proposition 65 requires that a clear and reasonable warning be provided prior to exposure to the identified chemicals. The method of warning should be a warning that appears where the product is sold. The Violator violated Proposition 65 because it failed to provide consumers using these Products with appropriate warnings that they are being exposed to benzene.

**Resolution of Noticed Claims.** Based on the allegations set forth in this notice, Ms. Aviles, Ms. S. Cooper, Ms. T. Cooper and Mr. Cooper intend to file a citizen enforcement lawsuit against P&G unless it agrees to provide clear and reasonable warnings for products sold or otherwise provided to consumers in the future to eliminate unknowing exposures to benzene, and pay an appropriate civil penalty based on the factors enumerated in California Health and Safety Code Section 25249.7(b).

I represent Ms. Aviles, Ms. S. Cooper, Ms. T. Cooper and Mr. Cooper in this matter, as a licensed member of the California bar, in good standing, since 2018.


## CERTIFICATE OF MERIT

I understand that "reasonable and meritorious case for the private action" means that the information provides a credible basis that all elements of the plaintiff's case can be established and the information did not prove that the alleged Violator will be able to establish any of the affirmative defenses set forth in the statute;

The copy of this Certificate of Merit served on the Attorney General attaches to it factual information sufficient to establish the basis for this certificate, including information identified in Health and Safety Code §25249.7(h)(2) (i.e., (1) the identity of the persons consulted with and relied on by the certifier, and (2) the facts, studies, or other data reviewed by those persons).

## Which deodorants and antiperspirants are contaminated with benzene and which are not?

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### *Answer:*

Benzene, which has been linked to blood cancers, has been reported in a spray deodorants and antiperspirants that were independently tested by [Valisure, LLC](#), a company that independently checks the chemical composition of medications and healthcare products.

**Benzene was found in 44 out of 86 distinct products from 30 brands of spray deodorants and antiperspirants.**

(Earlier in 2021, Valisure found [benzene in sun care products](#), several of which were later recalled by their distributors.)

FDA guidance suggests that no level of benzene is safe, and it is not permitted in these or other products.

Among sprays, **the highest average concentrations of benzene** (2 ppm to 16 ppm) were in 16 products from Secret, Tag, and Old Spice, Equate, Sure, Suave, Brut, and Right Guard — although not all products from these brands had high or detectable levels of benzene. The next highest average concentrations of benzene (0.1 to 2 ppm) were in eleven products from Secret, Right Guard, Summer's Eve, Suave, Old Spice, Soft & Dri, Victoria's Secret, and Powder Stick.

**Very low concentrations of benzene** (less than 0.1 ppm) were found in 17 products from Arrid, Bath & Body Works, Calvin Klein, Degree, Dove, Land of the Free, and Nautica.

**No detectable benzene** was found in sprays from Axe, Azzaro, Davidoff, Designer Imports, Duke Cannon, Gold Bond, Guy Laroche, Hollister, Kenneth Cole, Prince Matchabelli, and Speed Stick.

**We don't know the source of the benzene**, but it could relate to how a particular ingredient was manufactured, where it was sourced, or how it moved through the supply chain. Aluminum chlorohydrate (anhydrous) was the listed key active ingredient in most products, regardless of their level of benzene, and is unlikely to account for the presence of benzene. It is more likely that the benzene arose from other ingredients in the products, such as butane, a propellant.

Valisure, which conducted the testing, is asking for a recall of the contaminated batches and requesting FDA better define limits for benzene contamination in drug and cosmetic products. It is important to note that not all spray deodorants and antiperspirants contain benzene and that uncontaminated products are available.

#### **More about benzene:**

Benzene is known to cause cancer in humans according to the [U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention](#), the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, the World Health Organization, and other regulatory agencies. The National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health (NIOSH) defines [benzene as a carcinogen](#) and lists "inhalation, skin absorption, ingestion, skin and/or eye contact" as exposure routes.

#### **Test Results by Product:**

The table below shows the average concentration of benzene (in parts per million, or PPM) found in products, which are shown by name as well as the UPC code on their labels.

If more than one lot of a product was tested by Valisure and yielded a range of results, the average result is shown. Some products were also tested at a laboratory at Yale University, and those results are shown with an asterisk. (More details about the results and testing are available in [Valisure's FDA Citizen Petition on Benzene in Body Spray Products](#).)

The results are color-coded as follows:

- The highest concentrations of benzene were found in products shaded pink (2 ppm to 16 ppm) and orange (0.1 ppm to up to 2 ppm). It would seem advisable to avoid these products if possible.
- Smaller concentrations (up to 0.1 ppm) were found in products shaded yellow – you may also want to be cautious with these products.
- No benzene was detected in products shaded green (listed as "ND" for Not Detected), which were the majority of products.

If a product that you use is not on the list, we do not have information about it.


