## NOTICE OF VIOLATION

# California Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act

Unwarned Bystander Exposures to 1,3-Dichloropropene from Use of Soil Fumigants

June 29, 2023

This Notice of Violation (the "Notice") is provided to you pursuant to and in compliance with California Health and Safety Code section 25249.7(d).

- This Notice is provided by the Center for Environmental Health ("CEH"), 2201 Broadway, Suite 508, Oakland, CA 94612, (510) 655-3900. CEH is a nonprofit corporation dedicated to protecting the environment, improving human health, and supporting environmentally sound practices. Kaya Sugerman is the Illegal Toxic Threats Program Director and a responsible individual within CEH.

## **Description of Violation:**

- <u>Provision of Proposition 65</u>: This Notice covers California Health and Safety Code Section 25249.6.
- <u>Chemical(s) Involved</u>: The name of the listed chemical involved in these violations is 1,3-Dichloropropene ("1,3-D"). 1,3-D is the active ingredient in soil fumigants manufactured, distributed, and/or applied by the alleged violators.

Description of Exposure: This Notice addresses environmental exposures to 1,3-D. The exclusive source of these exposures is applications of soil fumigants containing 1,3-D ("Telone II"). The Dow Chemical Company ("Dow") is the exclusive manufacturer of Telone II sold in California. Teleos Ag Solutions, Inc. ("Teleos") is the exclusive distributor of Telone II used in California. In California, use of Telone II is regulated by placing annual caps on the amount of Telone II that can be used in each township in the state. Dow (historically) and Teleos (presently) pre-approve every application of Telone II in California, and are responsible for tracking, reporting, and ensuring township use limits are observed.

The use of Telone II to control pests in agricultural fields, which are manufactured by Dow and distributed by Teleos, results in human exposures to 1,3-D. 1,3-D is released into the air when Telone II is applied to agricultural fields in accordance with Telone II's labels. No clear and reasonable warning is provided regarding the carcinogenic hazards of 1,3-D to bystanders. This Notice does not challenge the sufficiency of the labeling of Telone II.

- <u>Time Period of Exposure</u>: The exposures are caused by applications of Telone II on the specific dates identified on the attached Exhibit 1. Future violations caused by the same conduct are likely because Telone II continues to be applied on a regular basis. The exposures themselves occur after Telone II is applied to fields. CEH is not seeking to hold Teleos responsible for any exposures that occurred prior to January 1, 2021. CEH is only seeking to hold TriCal and Nutrien responsible for exposures caused by each company's respective applications as indicated on Exhibit 1.
- Route of Exposure: The route of exposure for the violations is inhalation when individuals breathe the 1,3-D emitted in the air following applications of Telone II to the soil in agricultural fields.
- Location of Source of Exposures: The locations of the source of the exposures are identified on the attached Exhibit 1, which documents the Township, Range, Section, and Site ID for the locations of the source of the exposures. Township, Range, and Section identify where Telone II was applied within an approximately 1x1 square mile area, in accordance with the Public Land Survey System's division of land. Site ID, which is a code assigned by the Kern County Agricultural Commissioner, identifies the field where Telone II was applied. These exposures occur beyond any property owned or controlled by the alleged violators.

### **Resolution of Noticed Claims:**

Based on the allegations set forth in this Notice, CEH intends to file a citizen enforcement lawsuit against each alleged violator unless such violator agrees in a binding written instrument to remedy the violations alleged herein and to pay an appropriate civil penalty in accordance with the factors set forth in Health and Safety Code Section 25249.7. CEH is not seeking any changes to the labels of Telone II. If any alleged violator is interested in resolving this dispute without resorting to expensive and time-consuming litigation, please contact CEH through its counsel identified below. It should be noted that CEH cannot: (1)

finalize any settlement until after the 60-day notice period has expired; nor (2) speak for the Attorney General or any District or City Attorney who received CEH's 60-day Notice. Therefore, while reaching an agreement with CEH will resolve its claims, such agreement may not satisfy the public prosecutors.

#### **Preservation of Relevant Evidence:**

This Notice also serves as a demand that each alleged violator preserve and maintain all relevant evidence, including all electronic documents and data, pending resolution of this matter. Such relevant evidence includes but is not limited to all documents relating to exposures to 1,3-D caused by applications of Telone II by each alleged violator; efforts to comply with Proposition 65 with respect to such applications; and communications with any person relating to exposures to 1,3-D from such applications.
