**STIPULATION FOR ENTRY OF  
JUDGMENT**

1           1. The following constitutes the knowing and voluntary election and stipulation of the  
2 entity named below ("Company" or "Opt-In Defendant") to join as a Settling Defendant under  
3 the Consent Judgment previously entered by the Court in *Brimer v. The Boelter Companies,*  
4 *Inc.*, San Francisco Superior Court Case No. CGC 05 -440811 ("Action") and to be bound by  
5 the terms of that Consent Judgment.

6           2. At any time during the one-year period prior to the filing of this Stipulation  
7 ("Relevant Period"), the Company has employed ten (10) or more part-time or full-time  
8 persons and has manufactured, distributed, offered for use or sold one or more items in each of  
9 the following categories of Covered Products, as defined in the Consent Judgment (section 1.4)  
10 (check all that apply):

- 11            Glassware Food/Beverage Products ("Category A Products")
- 12            Glassware Non-Food/Beverage Products ("Category C Products")
- 13            Ceramicware Food/Beverage Products ("Category B Products")
- 14            Ceramicware Non-Food/Beverage Products ("Category D Products")

15           3. The categories of products identified above are hereafter designated "Covered  
16 Products" in the Action with respect to the Company.

17           4. At least one of the items in each of the categories checked above did not during the  
18 Relevant Period or does not currently meet the Reformulation Standards set forth for that  
19 category of Covered Products in section 2.3 of the Consent Judgment. The Company has not  
20 provided compliant Proposition 65 warnings in conjunction with the sale or use of all such  
21 Covered Products in California at all times during the Relevant Period.

22           5. The Company has not conducted a risk or exposure assessment for all Covered  
23 Products within each separate category checked above firmly establishing that the use of such  
24 Covered Products will result in an exposure in an amount less than that deemed permissible in  
25 22 Cal. Code Regs. §12805(b) (i.e., less than 0.5 micrograms of lead per day and/or less than  
26 4.1 micrograms of cadmium per day).

27

1           6. To the extent the Consent Judgment applies to the categories of Covered Products  
2 checked above, the Company agrees to be bound by the injunctive relief provisions of the  
3 Consent Judgment as it relates to each such category of Covered Products.

4           7. In conjunction with the execution of this Stipulation, the Company has provided the  
5 payments applicable to it as set forth in Table 14.4 of the Consent Judgment in the manner  
6 described in Exhibit E to the Consent Judgment. In this regard, the Company hereby  
7 represents and warrants that under the criteria set forth in subsections 14.4(a), (b), and (c) of  
8 the Consent Judgment, with respect to the Covered Products applicable to it pursuant to the  
9 categories checked in Paragraph 2 of this Stipulation, it is a (check only one)<sup>1</sup>:

- 10            (a) **Manufacturer** with combined sales in California of less than 350,000  
11           consumer units in calendar year 2004
- 12            (a.1) **Low Volume Manufacturer** with combined sales in California of less  
13           than 10,000 consumer units in calendar year 2004
- 14            (b) **Distributor and/or Importer** with combined sales in California of less than  
15           350,000 consumer units in calendar year 2004
- 16            (b.1) **Low Volume Distributor and/or Importer** with combined sales in  
17           California of less than 10,000 consumer units in calendar year 2004
- 18            (c) **Retailer and/or Amusement & Recreation Establishment**
- 19            (d) **Bar, Restaurant, Hotel, or Other Food/Beverage Service Defendant**
- 20            (e) **Opt-In Defendant with De Minimis Sales**, i.e., combined sales in  
21           California of less than 500 consumer units in calendar year 2004 (attach to this  
22           Stipulation a list of the names of all product lines (by narrative description and,  
23

25           <sup>1</sup> Any entity which has conducted activities which comprise more than one of the  
26 categories of business listed in (a)-(d) below shall be deemed to be a Manufacturer if 15% or  
27 more of its sales of Covered Products in California were the result of its Manufacturing of  
28 Covered Products; any entity otherwise in categories (c) or (d) shall be deemed to be a  
Distributor/Importer if 15% or more of its sales of Covered Products in California were the result  
of its Distributing/Importing of Covered Products.

1                   where available, UPC code) comprising these consumer units of Covered  
2                   Products).

3                   8. At least 65 days prior to the submissions of this Stipulation to the Court for entry,  
4 provided that it has been mailed to the address shown in Exhibit C attached hereto, the  
5 Company agrees to be deemed to have accepted service of a 60-day notice letter from Russell  
6 Brimer ("Brimer") alleging certain violations of Proposition 65 with respect to sales of the  
7 Covered Products identified herein.

8                   9. The Company hereby stipulates to be deemed to have voluntarily accepted service  
9 of the summons and complaint in this Action upon the filing of this Stipulation and agrees to  
10 be subject to the jurisdiction of the Court for purposes of the Consent Judgment.


11                   10. Future notices concerning this Stipulation and the Consent Judgment shall be  
12 provided to the Company at the address shown in Exhibit C as attached hereto. If the  
13 Company desires to change the individual and/or address designated to receive notice on its  
14 behalf, the Company shall provide notice to Brimer and Boelter's counsel at the addresses for  
15 them listed in Exhibit C to the Consent Judgment.

17 knowingly and voluntarily agree to be bound by, all terms and conditions of this Stipulation  
18 and the Consent Judgment as previously approved and entered by the San Francisco County  
19 Superior Court in this Action.

DECLARATION OF GEORGE ANTONAROS

3 I, George Antonaros, declare as follows:

4 1. I am a partner or managing member in the partnerships  
5 and business entity known as John T's Newark, dba John T's Unique  
6 Gifts, John T's Unique Gifts LLC, dba John T's Unique Gifts, and  
7 John T's Bakersfield, dba John T's Unique Gifts (collectively  
8 "John T's"). I have personal knowledge of the following facts,  
9 and if called to testify, could and would competently testify to  
10 them.

11 2. This declaration is being made in conjunction with John  
12 T's election to resolve any and all claims that could or have  
13 been raised against it in the action encaptioned, *Brimer v. John*  
14 *T's Unique Gifts*, Santa Clara County Superior Court Case No.  
15 10SCV035931 (the "Lawsuit") by the plaintiff, arising out of the  
16 sale of Covered Products (as defined below), by opting in to the  
17 settlement approved by the San Francisco County Superior Court in  
18 the matter of *Brimer v. The Boelter Companies et al.*, San  
19 Francisco County Superior Court Case No. CGC-05-440811  
20 (hereinafter the "Settlement").

21 3. I am the controller for John T's. As the controller, I  
22 am responsible for all financial aspects of the business,  
23 including overseeing its sales and accounting. I also personally  
24 review and authorize every product order made for the John T's  
25 stores. As such, I am familiar with the products carried in our  
26 stores. There are a total of ten John T's retail stores in  
27 California.

28 4. My understanding of Covered Products under the

1 Settlement, is that it includes glass or ceramicware products  
2 with colored artwork, designs and/or markings on the exterior  
3 surface that are manufactured, decorated, imported, distributed  
4 or offered for use or sale by a settling defendant and that are  
5 purchased and/or used by individuals in California for the  
6 storage, serving or consumption of food or beverages, including  
7 but not limited to, mugs, steins, carafes, bowls, drinking  
8 vessels, bottles, condiment dispensers, bowls cups, saucers,  
9 plates, trays, pitchers, punch bowls, serving utensils, serving  
10 platters and other like items. Covered Products also include  
11 glassware or ceramicware household products with colored artwork,  
12 designs and/or markings on the exterior surface that are  
13 manufactured, decorated, imported, distributed or offered for use  
14 or sale by a settling defendant and that are purchased and/or  
15 used by individuals in California that are not reasonably used  
16 for storing, serving or consuming foods or beverages such as  
17 vases, votive holders, ashtrays, coasters, napkin rings,  
18 centerpieces, and other like items. Collectively, these products  
19 are referred to herein as "Covered Products."

20 5. From February 24-28, 2006, my business partners, Jerry  
21 Carucci and John Antonaros, conducted testing for the presence of  
22 lead and cadmium in Covered Products (i.e., glassware and  
23 ceramicware products) carried by John T's stores. Following  
24 these testings, I compiled the test results in a spreadsheet  
25 describing the vendor from whom each tested product was acquired,  
26 the item, the type of item, the date the item was tested, which  
27 John T's store the tested item came from, the lead or cadmium  
28 test results, the swab number for the lead or cadmium test as

1 applicable, a reference to the photo number for the product as  
2 applicable, and other notes as applicable. The results of that  
3 testing are provided in the table attached hereto as Exhibit 1.

4 6. I understand that M. Cornell has already opted in to  
5 the Settlement, and therefore, any Covered Products John T's has  
6 purchased from M. Cornell are excluded from the Lawsuit.

7 7. I understand that Kalan LP has already opted in to the  
8 Settlement, and therefore, any Covered Products John T's has  
9 purchased from Kalan LP are excluded from the Lawsuit.

10 8. The following Covered Products carried by one or more  
11 John T's stores were acquired from vendors other than M. Cornell  
12 or Kalan LP and tested positive for the presence of lead:



26 9. None of the Covered Products carried by the John T's  
27 stores returned positive test results for the presence of  
28 cadmium.

1           10. John T's sold less than a combined total of 500  
2 consumer units of the Covered Products listed in Paragraph 8,  
3 above, in the calendar year 2004.

4           I declare under penalty of perjury under the laws of the  
5 State of California that the foregoing is true and correct.
