The following constitutes the knowing and voluntary election and stipulation of the entity named below ("Company" or "Opt-In Settling Defendant") to join as a Settling Defendant under the Amended Consent Judgment ("Consent Judgment") previously entered by the Court in the above-captioned actions, *Held v. Aldo U.S., Inc. and Aldo Group, Inc., et al.*, San Francisco Superior Court Case No. CGC-10-497729 and *Moore v.
