

SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 Parties

This Settlement Agreement is entered into by and between Dr. Whitney R. Leeman (“Leeman”) and Ivy Classic Industries, Inc. (“Ivy”), with Leeman and Ivy individually referred to as a “Party” and collectively as the “Parties.” Leeman is an individual residing in California who seeks to promote awareness of exposures to toxic chemicals and to improve human health by reducing or eliminating hazardous substances contained in consumer products. Ivy employs ten or more persons and is a person in the course of doing business for purposes of the Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986, Health and Safety Code section 25249.6 *et seq.* (“Proposition 65”).

1.2 General Allegations

Leeman alleges that Ivy has distributed for sale in the state of California, tools with vinyl/PVC grips and tape measures with vinyl/PVC grips that contain di(2-ethylhexyl)phthalate (“DEHP”) and lead without having first provided the clear and reasonable exposure warning required by Proposition 65. DEHP and lead are listed pursuant to Proposition 65 as chemicals that are known to the state of California to cause cancer, birth defects, and other reproductive harm.

1.3 Product Descriptions

The products covered by this Settlement Agreement are tools with vinyl/PVC grips and tape measures with vinyl/PVC grips containing DEHP and lead that are manufactured, sold, or distributed for sale in California by Ivy, including, but not limited to, the *Ivy Classic 4" Wall Stripper*, #11158, UPC #7 38226 11158 2, which allegedly contained DEHP, and products known as *Ivy Classic 25' x 1" Power Pro Grip*, #13225, UPC #7 38226 13225 9, which allegedly contained DEHP and lead, as well as the products identified on Exhibit A hereto. These tools shall, where appropriate, be referred to as the “Products.”

1.4 Notice of Violation

On or about November 15, 2013, Leeman served Ivy and certain requisite public enforcement agencies with a “60-Day Notice of Violation” (“Notice”) alleging that Ivy violated Proposition 65 by failing to warn its customers and consumers in California that the Products expose users to DEHP and lead. To the best of the Parties’ knowledge, no public enforcer has commenced and is diligently prosecuting the allegations set forth in the Notice.

1.5 No Admission

Ivy denies the material, factual, and legal allegations contained in the Notice and maintains that all of the products it has manufactured, sold, or distributed for sale in California, including the Products, have been, and are, in compliance with all laws. Nothing in this Settlement Agreement shall be construed as an admission by Ivy of any fact, finding, conclusion of law, issue of law, or violation of law; nor shall compliance with this Settlement Agreement constitute or be construed as an admission by Ivy of any fact, finding, conclusion of law, issue of law, or violation of law, the same being specifically denied by Ivy. This Section shall not, however, diminish or otherwise affect Ivy’s obligations, responsibilities, and duties under this Settlement Agreement.

1.6 Effective Date

For purposes of this Settlement Agreement, the term “Effective Date” shall mean March 31, 2014.

2. INJUNCTIVE RELIEF

2.1 Commitment to Reformulate Products

Commencing on the Effective Date, and continuing thereafter, Ivy commits to use its best efforts to assure that the Products it imports, distributes, ships, sells or offers to ship for sale in California, will be “Reformulated Products.”

2.2 Reformulated Products

Commencing on the Effective Date and continuing thereafter, Ivy shall use its best efforts to distribute for sale or purchase for sale in California, Reformulated Products. For purposes of

this Settlement Agreement, “Reformulated Products” shall mean Products that contain a maximum of 1,000 parts per million DEHP content when analyzed pursuant to U.S. Environmental Protection Agency testing methodologies 3580A and 8270C, and which contain less than or equal to 100 parts per million of lead in each accessible component when analyzed pursuant to EPA testing methodologies utilized by federal or state agencies for the purpose of determining lead content in a solid substance. Ivy may utilize any other testing methodology allowed by state or federal agencies for the purpose of determining DEHP and lead content in a solid substance to determine compliance with this Section.

3. Sales of Existing Products with Warnings

Nothing in this Settlement Agreement shall preclude Ivy from shipping and selling in California its existing inventory of Products. Ivy represents that it has already begun a warnings program for all tools with vinyl/PVC grips and that all such tools have Proposition 65-compliant warnings. Commencing 30 days following the Effective Date, Ivy agrees that it shall not distribute, ship, or sell, or cause to be distributed, shipped or sold, any Product are not Reformulated Products as defined in Section 2.2 will include a warning affixed to the packaging, labeling, or directly on each Product that states:

WARNING: This product contains a chemical known to the State of California to cause birth defects and other reproductive harm.

4. MONETARY PAYMENTS

4.1 Payments Pursuant to Health & Safety Code Section 25249.7(b)

In settlement of all the claims referred to in this Settlement Agreement, Ivy shall pay a total of \$21,000.00 in civil penalties in accordance with this Section. Each penalty payment will be allocated in accordance with California Health & Safety Code section 25249.12(c)(1) & (d), with 75% of the funds remitted to the California Office of Environmental Health Hazard Assessment (“OEHHA”) and the remaining 25% of the penalty remitted to Leeman, as follows:

4.1.1 Initial Civil Penalty

Ivy shall pay an initial civil penalty in the amount of \$8,000.00 on or before March 31, 2014. Ivy shall issue two separate checks to: (a) "OEHHA" in the amount of \$6,000.00; and (b) "The Chanler Group in Trust for Dr. Whitney R. Leeman" in the amount of \$2,000.00. All penalty payments shall be delivered to the addresses listed in Section 4.3 below.

4.1.2 Final Civil Penalty

Ivy shall pay a final civil penalty of \$13,000.00 on or before February 20, 2015. The final civil penalty shall be waived in its entirety, however, if, no later than February 10, 2015, an officer of Ivy provides Leeman with written certification that, as of the date of such certification and continuing into the future, Ivy has met the reformulation standard specified in Section 2 above, such that all Products manufactured, imported, distributed, sold and offered for sale in California by Ivy are Reformulated Products. If Ivy has met the reformulation standard specified in Section 2 above for fewer than all of the Products, then the written certification shall so state and the final civil penalty shall be reduced by the same percentage that the reformulated products bear to the total number of Products. Leeman must receive any such certification on or before February 10, 2015. The certification in lieu of a final civil penalty payment provided by this Section is a material term, and time is of the essence. If Ivy fails to provide a certificate of reformulation by February 10, 2015, Ivy shall issue two separate checks for its final civil penalty payments to: (a) "OEHHA" in the amount of \$9,750.00 of the final civil penalty; and (b) "The Chanler Group in Trust for Dr. Whitney R. Leeman" in the amount of \$3,250.00 of the final civil penalty.

4.2 Attorney Fees and Costs

The parties acknowledge that Leeman and her counsel offered to resolve this dispute without reaching terms on the amount of fees and costs to be reimbursed to them, thereby leaving this fee issue to be resolved after the material terms of the agreement had been settled. Ivy then expressed a desire to resolve the fee and cost issue shortly after the other settlement terms had been finalized. The parties then attempted to (and did) reach an accord on the

compensation due to Leeman and her counsel under general contract principles and the private attorney general doctrine codified at California Code of Civil Procedure section 1021.5, for all work performed through the mutual execution of this agreement. Ivy shall pay \$26,000 for fees and costs incurred as a result of investigating, bringing this matter to Ivy's attention, and negotiating a settlement in the public interest. Ivy shall issue a separate 1099 for fees and costs (EIN: 94-3171522), shall make the check payable to "The Chanler Group" and shall deliver payment on or before March 31, 2014, to the address listed in Section 4.3.1(a) below.

4.3 Payment Procedures

4.3.1 Issuance of Payments. Payments shall be delivered as follows:

With a copy of the checks payable to OEHHA mailed to The Chanler Group at the address set forth above in Section 4.3.1(a), as proof of payment to OEHHA.

4.3.2 Issuance of 1099 Forms. After each penalty payment, Ivy shall issue separate 1099 forms for each payment to Leeman, whose address and tax identification number

will be provided upon request after this Settlement Agreement is fully executed by the Parties, and OEHHA at the addresses listed in Section 4.3.1(b) above.

5. CLAIMS COVERED AND RELEASED

5.1 Leeman's Release of Ivy

This Settlement Agreement is a full, final, and binding resolution between Leeman and Ivy of any violation of Proposition 65 that was or could have been asserted by Leeman, on behalf of herself, or on behalf of her past and current agents, representatives, attorneys, successors, and assignees, against Ivy, its parents, subsidiaries, affiliated entities under common ownership, directors, officers, shareholders, employees, attorneys, and each entity to whom Ivy directly or indirectly distributes or sells the Products, including, without limitation, its downstream distributors, wholesalers, customers, retailers, franchisees, cooperative members, and licensees ("Downstream Releasees"), based on unwarned exposures to DEHP and lead contained in Products sold or distributed for sale by Ivy in California prior to the Effective Date.

In further consideration of the promises and agreements herein contained, Leeman, on her own behalf and on behalf of her past and current agents, representatives, attorneys, successors, and/or assignees, hereby waives all rights to institute or participate in, directly or indirectly, any form of legal action, and releases all claims that he may have against Ivy and Releasees, including, without limitation, all actions and causes of action, suits, liabilities, demands, obligations, damages, costs, fines, penalties, losses, or expenses, including, without limitation, investigation fees, expert fees, and attorneys' fees arising under Proposition 65 for unwarned exposures to DEHP and lead in Products manufactured, sold, or distributed for sale in California by Ivy prior to the Effective Date.

5.2 Ivy's Release of Leeman

Ivy, on its own behalf and on behalf of its past and current agents, representatives, attorneys, successors, and assignees, hereby waives any and all claims that it may have against Leeman and her attorneys and other representatives, for any and all actions taken or statements made by Leeman and her attorneys and other representatives, whether in the course of

investigating claims, seeking to enforce Proposition 65 against it in this matter, or with respect to the Products.

6. POST EXECUTION CONVERSION TO CONSENT JUDGMENT

Within twelve months of the execution of this Settlement Agreement, Ivy may request in writing that Leeman draft and file a complaint, incorporate the terms of this Settlement Agreement into a proposed consent judgment providing a release for the Products in the public interest, and seek court approval of the consent judgment pursuant to Health and Safety Code section 25249.7, or as may be otherwise allowed by law. If requested, Leeman and Ivy agree to reasonably cooperate and to use their best efforts, and those of their counsel, to obtain an entry of judgment in accordance with the terms of this Settlement Agreement by a superior court in California in a timely manner.

Pursuant to Code of Civil Procedure sections 1021 and 1021.5, if so requested, Ivy agrees to reimburse Leeman and her counsel for the reasonable fees and costs incurred in connection with work performed pursuant to this Section in an amount not to exceed \$8,000, exclusive of fees and cost on appeal, if any. Within ten (10) days of receiving a monthly invoice from Leeman's counsel for work performed under this Section, Ivy will remit payment to the address provided in Section 4.3.1(a)

7. SEVERABILITY

If, subsequent to the execution of this Settlement Agreement, any provision of this Settlement Agreement is held by a court to be unenforceable, the validity of the remaining provisions shall not be adversely affected.

8. GOVERNING LAW

The terms of this Settlement Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the state of California and apply within the state of California. In the event that Proposition 65 is repealed or is otherwise rendered inapplicable by reason of law generally, or as to the Products, then Ivy may provide written notice to Leeman of any asserted change in the law, and have no further

obligations pursuant to this Settlement Agreement, with respect to, and to the extent that, the Products are so affected.

9. NOTICES

Unless specified herein, all correspondence and notices required to be provided pursuant to this Settlement Agreement shall be in writing and sent by: (i) personal delivery; (ii) first-class, registered or certified mail, return receipt requested; or (iii) a recognized overnight courier on any party by the other party at the following addresses:

10. COUNTERPARTS; FACSIMILE SIGNATURES

This Settlement Agreement may be executed in counterparts, and by facsimile or portable document format (pdf) signature, each of which shall be deemed an original, and all of which, when taken together, shall constitute one and the same document.

11. POST-EXECUTION ACTIVITIES

Leeman agrees to comply with the reporting form requirements referenced in Health and Safety Code section 25249.7(f).

12. **MODIFICATION**

This Settlement Agreement may be modified only by a written agreement of the Parties.

13. **AUTHORIZATION**

The undersigned are authorized to execute this Settlement Agreement on behalf of their respective Parties and have read, understood and agree to all of the terms and conditions of this Settlement Agreement.
