

SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 Parties

This Settlement Agreement is entered into by and between Kim Embry ("Embry"), on the one hand, and Divvies, LLC ("Divvies"), on the other hand, with Embry and Divvies each individually referred to as a "Party" and collectively as the "Parties." Embry is an individual residing in the State of California who seeks to promote awareness of exposures to toxic chemicals and to improve human health by reducing or eliminating hazardous substances used in consumer products. Divvies is a person in the course of doing business for purposes of the Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986, California Health and Safety Code § 25249.6 *et seq.* ("Proposition 65").

1.2 General Allegations

Embry alleges that Divvies manufactures, sells, and distributes for sale in California, chocolate brownie minis that contain acrylamide and that it does so without first providing the health hazard warning required by Proposition 65. Acrylamide is listed pursuant to Proposition 65 as a chemical known to the State of California to cause cancer and birth defects or other reproductive harm.

1.3 Product Description

The product covered by this Settlement Agreement is defined as, and expressly limited to, Divvies Chocolate Brownie Minis, that contains acrylamide and that is manufactured, sold or distributed for sale in California by Divvies.

1.4 Notice of Violation

On July 12, 2019, Embry served Divvies, Sprouts Farmers Market, Inc., the California Attorney General and other requisite public enforcers with a 60-Day Notice of Violation ("Notice"), alleging that Divvies violated Proposition 65 when it failed to warn its customers and consumers in California of the health risks associated with exposures to Acrylamide from the Product. To the best of the Parties' knowledge, no public enforcer has commenced and is diligently prosecuting an action to enforce the violations alleged in the Notice.

1.5 No Admission

Divvies denies the material, factual, and legal allegations in the Notice and maintains that all of the product it sold and/or distributed for sale in California, including the Product, have been, and are, in compliance with all laws. Nothing in this Settlement Agreement shall be construed as an admission by Divvies of any fact, finding, conclusion, issue of law or violation of law, nor shall compliance with this Settlement Agreement constitute or be construed as an admission by Divvies of any fact, finding, conclusion, issue of law or violation of law, such being specifically denied by Divvies. This Section shall not, however, diminish or otherwise affect Divvies' obligations, responsibilities and duties under this Settlement Agreement.

1.6 Effective Date

For purposes of this Settlement Agreement, the term "Effective Date" shall mean ninety (90) days following the execution of this Settlement Agreement by the Parties.

2. INJUNCTIVE RELIEF

2.1 Clear and Reasonable Warnings

Commencing on the Effective Date, and continuing thereafter, Divvies agrees to only manufacture for sale, purchase for sale, import for sale, or distribute for sale in or into California the Product that is sold with a health hazard warning as provided for in Section 2.2.

2.2 General Warning Requirements

Divvies agrees that each warning shall be prominently placed with such conspicuousness, as compared with other words, statements, designs, or devices as to render it likely to be read and understood by an ordinary individual under customary conditions before purchase or use. Each warning shall be provided in a manner such that the consumer or user understands to which *specific* Product the warning applies, so as to minimize the risk of consumer confusion.

For purposes of this Settlement Agreement, a clear and reasonable warning for the Product shall consist of a warning affixed to the packaging, label, tag, or directly to each Product sold in California by Divvies that contains the following statements:

- 1) **WARNING:** This product can expose you to chemicals including Acrylamide, which is known to the State of California to cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm. For more information go to www.P65Warnings.ca.gov.
- 2) **WARNING:** Cancer and Reproductive Harm – www.P65Warnings.cs.gov

The warning shall also include a symbol consisting of a black exclamation point in a yellow equilateral triangle with a bold black outline. The symbol shall be placed to the left of the text of the warning, in a size no smaller than the height of the word “WARNING”. The same warning shall be posted on any websites where the Product is sold in California.

2.3 Grace Period for Existing Inventory of Products

The injunctive requirements of Section 2 shall not apply to Products that are already in the stream of commerce as of the Effective Date., which Products are expressly subject to the releases provided in Section 4.1.

3. MONETARY SETTLEMENT TERMS

3.1 Civil Penalty Payment

Pursuant to Health and Safety Code § 25249.7(b)(2), and in settlement of all claims alleged in the Notice or referred to in this Settlement Agreement, Divvies agrees to pay two thousand dollars (\$2,000.00) in civil penalties. The penalty payment will be allocated in accordance with California Health and Safety Code §§ 25249.12(c)(1) & (d), with 75% of the penalty amount paid to the California Office of Environmental Health Hazard Assessment (“OEHHA”) and the remaining 25% of the penalty amount retained by Embry. On or before May 15, 2020, Divvies shall issue two separate checks for the initial civil penalty payment to (a) “OEHHA” in the amount of one thousand five hundred dollars (\$1,500.00) and (b) Kim Embry, payable to the Glick Law Group Client Trust Account, in the amount of five hundred dollars (\$500).

3.2 Attorney Fees and Costs

The Parties reached an accord on the compensation due to Embry and her counsel under the private attorney general doctrine and principles of contract law. Under these legal principles, Divvies agrees to pay eighteen thousand dollars (\$18,000.00) to Embry and her counsel for all fees and costs incurred in investigating, bringing this matter to the attention of Divvies' negotiating a settlement. Divvies' initial payment shall be delivered in the form of two checks: (1) one check for one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) payable to "Glick Law Group"; and (2) one check for one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) payable to "Nicholas & Tomasevic, LLP" on or before May 15th, 2020. Beginning June 15, 2020, and continuing on the 15th of each month until September 15, 2020, Divvies' payment shall be delivered monthly in the form of two checks: (1) one check for two thousand dollars (\$2,000.00) payable to "Glick Law Group"; and (2) one check for two thousand dollars (\$2,000.00) payable to "Nicholas & Tomasevic, LLP."

3.4 Tax Documentation

Divvies agrees to provide a completed IRS 1099 for its payments to, and Embry agrees to provide IRS W-9 forms for, each of the payees under this Settlement Agreement. The Parties acknowledge that Divvies cannot issue any settlement payments pursuant to Section 3.1 and 3.2 above until after Divvies receives the requisite W-9 forms from Embry's counsel.

4. CLAIMS COVERED AND RELEASED

4.1 Embry's Release of Divvies

This Settlement Agreement is a full, final, and binding resolution between Embry, on her own behalf and not on behalf of the public, and Divvies of any violation of Proposition 65 that was or could have been asserted by Embry, on her own behalf, on behalf of her past and current agents, representatives, attorneys, successors and assignees, against Divvies and each of its respective parents, subsidiaries, affiliated entities under common ownership, directors, officers, members, employees, attorneys, each upstream entity from whom the Product was purchased by Divvies, and each entity to whom Divvies directly or indirectly distributes or sells the Product, including, but not limited to, its downstream distributors, wholesalers, customers, retailers, franchisees, cooperative members and licensees ("Releasees"), based on the failure to warn about exposures to Acrylamide in the Product manufactured, sold or distributed for sale in California by Divvies before the Effective Date, as alleged in the Notice.

In further consideration of the promises and agreements herein contained, Embry on her

own behalf and not on behalf of the public, on behalf of her past and current agents, representatives, attorneys, successors and assignees hereby waives any and all rights she may have to institute or participate in, directly or indirectly, any form of legal action and releases all claims against Divvies and Releasees including, without limitation, all actions and causes of action, suits, liabilities, demands, obligations, damages, costs, fines, penalties, losses or expenses including, but not exclusively, investigation fees, expert fees and attorney fees arising under Proposition 65 with respect to the alleged or actual failure to warn about exposures to Acrylamide in the Product manufactured, distributed, sold or offered for sale Divvies, before the Effective Date.

4.2 Divvies' Release of Embry

Divvies, on its own behalf and on behalf of its past and current agents, representatives, attorneys, successors, and assignees, hereby waives any and all claims against Embry and her attorneys and other representatives, for any and all actions taken or statements made by Embry and her attorneys and other representatives, whether in the course of investigating claims, otherwise seeking to enforce Proposition 65 against it in this matter, or with respect to the Product.

4.3 Mutual Release of Known and Unknown Claims

Embry, on behalf of herself and her agents, attorneys, representatives, successors, and assigns, in her respective individual capacity only and not in her representative capacity, and Divvies, each provide a general release of the other including the Releasees herein which shall be effective as a full and final accord and satisfaction, as a bar to all claims of any nature, character or kind, known or unknown, suspected or unsuspected, arising out of alleged violations of Proposition 65 with respect to the Products. Embry and Divvies each acknowledge that they are each familiar with Section 1542 of the California Civil Code, which provides as follows:

A general release does not extend to claims that the creditor or releasing party does not know or suspect to exist in his or her favor at the time of executing the release, and that if known by him or her must have materially affected his or her settlement with the debtor or released party.

5. SEVERABILITY

If, subsequent to the execution of this Settlement Agreement, any provision of this Settlement Agreement is held by a court to be unenforceable, the validity of the remaining provisions shall not be adversely affected.

6. GOVERNING LAW

The terms of this Settlement Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of California and apply within the State of California.

7. NOTICE

Unless specified herein, all correspondence and notice required to be provided pursuant to this Settlement Agreement shall be in writing and sent by: (a) personal delivery; (b) first-class, registered or certified mail, return receipt requested; or (c) a recognized overnight courier on any Party by the other at the following addresses:

8. COUNTERPARTS; FACSIMILE SIGNATURES

This Settlement Agreement may be executed in counterparts and by facsimile or portable document format (PDF) signature, each of which shall be deemed an original, and all of which, when taken together, shall constitute one and the same document.

9. **COMPLIANCE WITH HEALTH & SAFETY CODE § 25249.7(f)**

Embry and her attorneys agree to comply with the reporting form requirements referenced in California Health and Safety Code § 25249.7(f).

10. **MODIFICATION**

This Settlement Agreement may be modified only by written agreement of the Parties.

11. **AUTHORIZATION**


