INTRODUCTION

1.1 Parties

This Consent Judgment is entered into by and between Environmental Health Advocates, Inc., ("EHA" or "Plaintiff") and Santo Remedio, Inc., ("Defendant" or "Santo Remedio") with EHA and Santo Remedio each individually referred to as a "Party" and collectively referred to as the "Parties."

1.2 Plaintiff

EHA is a corporation organized in the state of California, acting in the interest of the general public. It seeks to promote awareness of exposures to toxic chemicals and to improve human health by reducing or eliminating hazardous substances contained in consumer products.

1.3 Defendant

Santo Remedio employs ten or more individuals and for purposes of this Consent Judgment only, is a "person in the course of doing business" for purposes of the Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986, Health and Safety Code section 25249.6 et seq. ("Proposition 65").

1.4

General Allegations

EHA alleges that Santo Remedio manufactures, imports, sells, and distributes for sale Colon Plus Detoxifying Fiber Blend that contains lead. EHA further alleges that Santo Remedio does so without providing a sufficient health hazard warning as required by Proposition 65 and related Regulations. Santo Remedio denies these allegations and asserts that its products are safe and in compliance with all applicable laws, rules and regulations.

1.5 Notice of Violation

On or around February 29, 2024, EHA served Defendant Santo Remedio, Inc., Amazon.com, Inc., the California Attorney General, and all other required public enforcement agencies with a 60-Day Notice of Violation of Proposition 65 ("Notice"). The Notice alleged that Santo Remedio had violated Proposition 65 by failing to sufficiently warn consumers in California of the health hazards associated with exposures to lead contained in dietary supplements products, including but not limited Colon Plus Detoxifying Fiber Blend manufactured or processed by Santo Remedio that allegedly contain lead and are imported, sold, shipped, delivered, or distributed for sale to consumers in California by Releasees (as defined in section 4.1). No public enforcer has commenced or is otherwise prosecuting an action to enforce the violations alleged in the Notice.

1.6 Product Description

The products covered by this Consent Judgment are dietary supplements products, including but not limited to Colon Plus Detoxifying Fiber Blend manufactured or processed by Santo Remedio that allegedly contain lead and are imported, sold, shipped, delivered, or distributed for sale to consumers in California by Releasees (as defined in section 4.1) ("Covered Products").

1.7 State of the Pleadings

On or around May 17, 2024, EHA filed a Complaint against Santo Remedio for the alleged violations of Proposition 65 that are the subject of the Notice ("Complaint").

1.8 No Admission

Santo Remedio denies all factual and legal allegations of the Notice and Complaint and maintains that all of the products it has manufactured, imported, sold, and/or distributed for sale in California, including Covered Products, have been, and are, in compliance with all applicable laws, rules and regulations. Nothing in this Consent Judgment shall be construed as an admission of any fact, finding, conclusion of law, issue of law, or violation of law, nor shall compliance with this Consent Judgment be construed as an admission of any fact, finding, conclusion of law, or violation of any fact, finding, conclusion of law, or violation of any fact, finding, conclusion of law, or violation of any fact, finding, conclusion of law, or violation of any fact, finding, conclusion of law, issue of law, or violation of sale and the construed as an admission of any fact, finding, conclusion of law, issue of law, or violation of sale and the construed as an admission of any fact, finding, conclusion of law, issue of law, or violation of law. This Section shall not, however, diminish or otherwise affect Santo Remedio's obligations, responsibilities, and duties under this Consent Judgment.

1.9 Jurisdiction

For purposes of this Consent Judgment and the Complaint only, the Parties stipulate that this Court has jurisdiction over Santo Remedio as to the allegations in the Complaint, that venue is proper in the County of Alameda, and that the Court has jurisdiction to enter and enforce the provisions of this Consent Judgment pursuant to Proposition 65 and Code of Civil Procedure section 664.6.

1.10 Effective Date

For purposes of this Consent Judgment, the term "Effective Date" means the date on which this Consent Judgment is approved by the Court, as discussed in Section 5, and all Parties have been provided with a copy.

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1.11 Compliance Date

For purposes of this Consent Judgment, the term "Compliance Date" means ninety (90) days after the Effective Date.

2. <u>INJUNCTIVE RELIEF</u>

2.1 Reformulation of the Covered Products

Beginning on or before the Compliance Date, Santo Remedio shall be permanently enjoined from manufacturing, distributing, or directly selling in the State of California, any Covered Product that exposes a person to a "Daily Lead Exposure Level" of more than 0.5 micrograms of lead based on a single serving per day unless such Covered Products comply with the warning requirements of Section 2.2. The "Daily Lead Exposure Level" shall be calculated by multiplying the recommended serving size in Covered Product by the concentration of lead in Covered Products. As used in this Section 2, "distributed for sale in CA" means to directly ship Covered Products into California or to sell Covered Products to a distributor Santo Remedio knows will sell Covered Products in California.

Clear and Reasonable Warnings

For Covered Products that contain lead in a concentration exceeding the Reformulation Standard set forth in section 2.1 above, and which are distributed or directly sold by Santo Remedio in the State of California on or after the Compliance Date, Santo Remedio shall provide one of the following warning statements.

Option 1:

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WARNING: Consuming this product can expose you to chemicals including Lead, which are known to the State of California to cause cancer and birth defects or other reproductive harm. For more information, go to www.P65Warnings.ca.gov/food.

Option 2:

WARNING: Cancer and Reproductive Harm – www.P65Warnings.ca.gov/food.

This warning statement shall be enclosed in a box and prominently displayed on the Covered Products, on the packing of the Covered Products, or on a placard, shelf tag, or sign provided that the statement is displayed with such conspicuousness, as compared with other words, statements, or designs as to render it likely to be read and understood by an ordinary individual prior to sale. If the

warning statement is displayed on the Covered Products' packaging, it must be in a type size no smaller than the largest type size used for other consumer information on the product. In no case shall a warning 2 statement displayed on the Covered Products' packaging appear in a type size smaller than 6-point type. If the Covered Products' packaging contains consumer information in a foreign language, a 5 warning statement in that language is required.

As set forth in Cal. Code Regs. Tit. 27, § 25602(b), to the extent Covered Products are sold online, a warning that complies with the content requirements of Cal. Code Regs Tit. 27, § 25603(a) must be provided by including either the warning or a clearly marked hyperlink using the word "WARNING" 8 on the product display page, or by otherwise prominently displaying the warning to the purchaser prior to completing the purchase. If an on-product warning is provided pursuant to Cal. Code Regs. Tit. 27, 10 § 25603(a), the warning provided on the website may use the same content as the on-product warning. For purposes of this section, a warning is not prominently displayed if the purchaser must search for it 12 in the general content of the website. These requirements extend to any websites under the exclusive control of Santo Remedio where Covered Products are sold into California. In addition, Santo Remedio 14 shall instruct any third-party website to which it directly sells its Covered Products to include the same 15 online warning, as set forth above, as a condition of selling the Covered Products in California. 16

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Compliance with Warning Regulations.

Defendant shall be deemed to be in compliance with this Consent Judgment by adhering to §2 of this Consent Judgment or by complying with warning requirements adopted by OEHHA applicable to the Covered Product and exposures at issue after the Effective Date.

2.4 Sell-Through Period

Notwithstanding anything else in this Consent Judgment, Covered Products that are 22 manufactured, packaged, or put into commerce on or before the Compliance Date shall be subject to 23 the release of liability pursuant to this Consent Judgment, without regard to when such Covered 24 Products were, or are in the future, distributed or sold to customers. As a result, the obligations of Santo 25 Remedio, or any Releasees (if applicable), stated in this Section 2 do not apply to Covered Products in 26 the process of manufacture, manufactured, packaged or in the process of being packaged, or put into 27 28 commerce prior to the Compliance Date.

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MONETARY SETTLEMENT TERMS

3.1 Settlement Amount

Santo Remedio shall pay fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00) in settlement and total satisfaction of all the claims referred to in the Notice(s), the Complaint, and this Consent Judgment. This includes civil penalties in the amount of five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00) pursuant to Health and Safety Code section 25249.7(b) and attorneys' fees and costs in the amount of fourty-five thousand dollars (\$45,000.00) pursuant to Code of Civil Procedure section 1021.5.

3.2 Civil Penalty

The portion of the settlement attributable to civil penalties shall be allocated according to Health and Safety Code section 25249.12(c)(1) and (d), with seventy-five percent (75%) of the penalty paid to the California Office of Environmental Health Hazard Assessment ("OEHHA"), and the remaining twenty-five percent (25%) of the penalty paid to EHA individually. The five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00) in civil penalties shall be paid as follows:

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- One payment of \$3,750.00 to OEHHA, due thirty (30) days after the Effective Date.
- One payment of \$1,250.00 to EHA, due thirty (30) days after the Effective Date.

Santo Remedio agrees to provide EHA's counsel with a copy of the check payable to OEHHA, simultaneous with its penalty payment to EHA.

Plaintiff and its counsel will provide completed IRS 1099, W-9, or other tax forms as required. Relevant information is set out below:

All payments referenced in this section shall be paid within thirty (30) days of the Effective Date. EHA shall provide Santo Remedio the necessary documentation to effectuate payment at least ten (10) days prior to its due date. Santo Remedio shall be excused for any late payment caused by EHA's failure to timely produce the necessary documentation to effectuate payment.

3.3 Attorney's Fees and Costs

The portion of the settlement attributable to attorneys' fees and costs shall be paid to EHA's counsel, who are entitled to attorneys' fees and costs incurred by it in this action, including but not limited to investigating potential violations, bringing this matter to Santo Remedio's attention, as well as litigating and negotiating a settlement in the public interest.

Santo Remedio shall provide its payment for civil penalty and for attorneys' fees and costs to EHA's counsel by physical check or by electronic means, including wire transfers, at Santo Remedio's discretion, as follows: fourty-five thousand dollars (\$45,000.00) in Attorney's Fees and Costs shall be paid as one payment, due thirty (30) days after the Effective Date.

CLAIMS COVERED AND RELEASE

EHA's Public Release of Proposition 65 Claims 4.1

Plaintiff, acting on its own behalf and in the public interest, releases Santo Remedio, and its parents, shareholders, owners, managers, officers, representatives, subsidiaries, affiliates, divisions, subdivisions, subsidiaries, partners, sister companies, directors, officers, principals, agents, employees, attorneys, insurers, accountants, predecessors, successors, licensors, licensees, and assigns ("Defendant Entities"), and each entity to whom Defendant directly or indirectly obtains and to whom they directly or indirectly distribute, ship, or sell the Covered Products, including but not limited to upstream and downstream manufacturers, suppliers, distributors, wholesalers, customers, retailers (including but not limited to Amazon.com, Inc.), and marketplaces franchisees, franchisors, cooperative members, suppliers, licensees, and licensors, and all of the foregoing entities' owners, directors, officers, agents, principals, employees, attorneys, insurers, accountants, representatives, predecessors, successors, and assigns (collectively referred to as the "Releasees") from all claims for violations of Proposition 65 through the Effective Date based on exposure to lead from Covered Products as set forth in the Notice(s). Compliance with the terms of this Consent Judgment constitutes compliance with Proposition 65 with respect to exposures to lead from Covered Products as set forth in the Notice(s). This Consent Judgment is a full, final, and binding resolution of all claims under Proposition 65 that were or could have been asserted against Santo Remedio and/or Releasees for failure to comply with Proposition 65 for alleged exposure to lead from Covered Products. This release does not extend to any third-party retailers selling the product on a website who, after receiving instruction from Santo Remedio to include a warning as set forth above in section 2.2, do not include such a warning.

4.2 **EHA's Individual Release of Claims**

EHA, in its individual capacity, also provides a release to Santo Remedio and/or Releasees, which shall be a full and final accord and satisfaction of, as well as a bar to, all actions, causes of action, obligations, costs, expenses, attorneys' fees, damages, losses, claims, liabilities, and demands of every nature, character, and kind, whether known or unknown, suspected or unsuspected, arising out of alleged or actual exposures to lead in Covered Products manufactured, imported, sold, or distributed 27 28 by Santo Remedio before the Effective Date.

4.3 Santo Remedio's Release of EHA

Santo Remedio on its own behalf, and on behalf of Releasees as well as its past and current agents, representatives, attorneys, successors, and assignees, hereby waives any and all claims against EHA and its attorneys and other representatives, for any and all actions taken or statements made by EHA and its attorneys and other representatives, whether in the course of investigating claims, otherwise seeking to enforce Proposition 65 against them, in this matter or with respect to the Covered Products.

In addition to the foregoing, EHA, on behalf of itself, its past and current agents, representatives, attorneys, and successors and assignees, and *not* in its representative capacity, hereby waives all rights to institute or participate in, directly or indirectly, any form of legal or administrative action and releases Santo Remedio, Defendant Entities and Releasees, from any and all manner of actions, causes of action, claims, demands, rights, suits, obligations, debts, contracts, agreements, promises, liabilities, damages, charges, losses, costs, expenses, and attorneys' fees, of any nature whatsoever, known or unknown, in law or equity, fixed or contingent, now or in the future, with respect to any alleged violations of Proposition 65 or any other statutory or common law claims related to or arising from Covered Products manufactured, distributed, or sold by Santo Remedio that have been or could have been asserted by EHA regarding the failure to warn about exposure to lead in connection with the Covered Products manufactured, distributed, sold or offered for sale by Santo Remedio prior to the Compliance Date. With respect to the foregoing waivers and releases in this paragraph, EHA, on its own behalf and not on behalf of the general public, hereby specifically waives any and all rights and benefits which it now has, or in the future may have, conferred by virtue of the provisions of § 1542 of the California Civil Code, which provides as follows:

A GENERAL RELEASE DOES NOT EXTEND TO CLAIMS THAT THE CREDITOR OR
RELEASING PARTY DOES NOT KNOW OR SUSPECT TO EXIST IN HIS OR HER FAVOR AT
THE TIME OF EXECUTING THE RELEASE AND THAT, IF KNOWN BY HIM OR HER, WOULD
HAVE MATERIALLY AFFECTED HIS OR HER SETTLEMENT WITH THE DEBTOR OR
RELEASED PARTY

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4.4 No Other Known Claims or Violations

EHA and EHA's counsel affirm that they are not presently aware of any actual or alleged violations of Proposition 65 by Santo Remedio or for which Santo Remedio bears legal responsibility other than those that are fully resolved by this Consent Judgment.

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5.

COURT APPROVAL

This Consent Judgment is not effective until it is approved by the Court and shall be null and void if it is not approved by the Court within one year after it has been fully executed by the Parties, or by such additional time as the Parties may agree to in writing.

6. <u>SEVERABILITY</u>

Subsequent to the Court's approval and entry of this Consent Judgment, if any provision is held by a court to be unenforceable, the validity of the remaining provisions shall not be adversely affected.

7. <u>GOVERNING LAW</u>

The terms of this Consent Judgment shall be governed by the laws of the State of California and apply within the State of California. In the event that Proposition 65, either as a whole or as specifically applicable to lead or the Covered Products, is repealed or federally preempted, or if new or different safe harbor levels are established as applicable to the Covered Products, or if Proposition 65 is otherwise rendered inapplicable to the Covered Products and/or to lead, or if any of the provisions of this Consent Judgment are specifically rendered inapplicable or no longer required as to the Covered Products as a result of any such change in the law, then Santo Remedio may provide written notice to Plaintiff of any asserted change in the law, and Santo Remedio may seek Court approval of a modification of this Consent Judgment such that it shall have no further obligations pursuant to this Consent Judgment with respect to, and to the extent that the Covered Products are so affected.

8. <u>NOTICE</u>

Unless otherwise specified herein, all correspondence and notice required by this Consent Judgment shall be in writing and sent by: (i) personal delivery; (ii) first-class, registered, or certified mail, return receipt requested; or (iii) a recognized overnight courier; and (iv) with a copy by email; to the following addresses:

COUNTERPARTS; DIGITAL SIGNATURES

This Consent Judgment may be executed in counterparts and by facsimile signature, each of which shall be deemed an original, and all of which, when taken together, shall constitute one and the same document.

10. <u>POST EXECUTION ACTIVITIES</u>

EHA agrees to comply with the reporting form requirements referenced in Health and Safety Code section 25249.7(f). The Parties further acknowledge that, pursuant to Health and Safety Code section 25249.7(f), a noticed motion is required to obtain judicial approval of the settlement, which motion EHA shall draft and file. In furtherance of obtaining such approval, the Parties agree to mutually employ their reasonable best efforts, including those of their counsel, to support the entry of this agreement as judgment, and to obtain judicial approval of their settlement in a timely manner. For purposes of this Section, "best efforts" shall include, at a minimum, supporting the motion for approval, responding to any objection that any third-party may make, and appearing at the hearing before the Court if so requested.

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11.

MODIFICATION AND ENFORCEMENT

11.1. This Consent Judgment may be modified from time to time by express written agreement of the Parties to which any such modification would apply, with the approval of the Court, or by an order of this Court upon motion and in accordance with law. Notwithstanding the foregoing, if a California court enters judgment in the Action or another Proposition 65 enforcement action over exposure to lead in Covered Products or product substantially similar to Covered Products that imposes different injunctive relief than what is set forth in this Consent Judgment, Santo Remedio may seek Court approval of a modification of Section 2 of this Consent Judgment to conform with the injunctive

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relief provided in such judgment.

11.2 Only EHA may enforce the terms of this Consent Judgment. If a dispute arises with respect to either Party's compliance with the terms of this Consent Judgment, the Parties shall meet and confer in writing and endeavor to resolve the dispute in an amicable manner. No action may be filed in the absence of such good faith attempt to resolve the dispute beforehand. Should an exceedance of the reformulation standard(s) in Section 2 be alleged, Santo Remedio must be provided with written notice and data supporting such an allegation and thirty (30) days to address the allegations before an enforcement motion may be filed. No violation of this Consent Judgment shall be deemed to occur if Santo Remedio demonstrates that its own testing of the Covered Product at issue by an accredited lab is in accordance with Section 2. In any action to enforce the terms of this Consent Judgment, the prevailing party shall be entitled to its reasonable attorneys' fees and costs.

11.3 The inability of Santo Remedio to comply with any deadline set forth in this Consent Judgment due to an act of terrorism, fire, earthquake, civil disorders, war, or act of God that is beyond the reasonable control of Santo Remedio shall be grounds to move for modification of the deadlines set forth in this Consent Judgment.

12.

AUTHORIZATION

The undersigned are authorized to execute this Consent Judgment and acknowledge that they have read, understand, and agree to all of the terms and conditions contained herein.

13. <u>COMPLIANCE WITH HEALTH & SAFETY CODE § 25249.7(f)/COURT</u> <u>APPROVAL</u>

EHA agrees to comply with the requirements set forth in California Health & Safety Code § 25249.7(f) and to promptly bring a Motion for Approval of this Consent Judgment. Defendant agrees it shall support approval of such Motion. This Consent Judgment shall not be effective until it is approved and entered by the Court and shall be null and void if, for any reason, it is not approved by the Court. In such case, the Parties agree to meet and confer on how to proceed and if such agreement is not reached within thirty (30) days, the case shall proceed on its normal course. If the Court approves this Consent Judgment and is reversed or vacated by an appellate court, the Parties shall meet and confer as to whether

to modify the terms of this Consent Judgment. If the Parties do not jointly agree on a course of action to take, the case shall proceed on its normal course on the trial court's calendar.

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14. <u>GOOD FAITH ATTEMPT TO RESOLVE DISPUTES</u>

If a dispute arises with respect to either Party's compliance with the terms of this Consent Judgment entered by the Court, the Parties shall meet and confer in person, or by telephone, and/or in writing and endeavor to resolve the dispute in an amicable manner. No action or motion may be filed in the absence of such a good faith attempt to resolve the dispute beforehand.

15. <u>ENTIRE AGREEMENT</u>

This Consent Judgment contains the sole and entire agreement and understanding of the Parties with respect to the entire subject matter herein, and any and all prior discussions, negotiations, commitments, and understandings related hereto. No representations, oral or otherwise, express or implied, other than those contained herein have been made by any Party. No other agreements, oral or otherwise, unless specifically referred to herein, shall be deemed to exist or to bind any Party.

16. <u>ATTORNEY'S FEES</u>

A Party who unsuccessfully brings or contests an action arising out of this Consent Judgment shall be required to pay the prevailing party's reasonable attorney's fees and costs. Nothing in this Section shall preclude a Party from seeking an award of sanctions pursuant to law.

17. <u>RETENTION OF JURISDICTION</u>

This Court shall retain jurisdiction of this matter to implement or modify the Consent Judgment.

18. <u>SUCCESSORS AND ASSIGNS</u>

This Consent Judgment shall apply to and be binding upon EHA and each Settling Defendant, and their respective divisions, subdivisions, and subsidiaries, and the successors or assigns of any of them.

19. <u>AUTHORIZATION</u>

The undersigned are authorized to execute this Consent Judgment on behalf of their respective Parties and have read, understood, and agree to all of the terms and conditions of this document and certify that he or she is fully authorized by the Party he or she represents to execute the Consent Judgment on behalf of the Party represented and legally bind that Party. Except as explicitly provided herein each Party is to bear its own fees and costs.
