SETTLEMENT AND RELEASE AGREEMENT

1. INTRODUCTION

1.1. Clean Product Advocates, LLC and Beaver Street Fisheries

This Settlement Agreement is entered into by and between Clean Products Advocates, LLC ("CPA"), on the one hand, and Beaver Street Fisheries LLC (formerly known as Beaver Street Fisheries, Inc.) and Sea Best Corporation (separately and collectively "Beaver Street Fisheries"), on the other hand, with CPA and Beaver Street Fisheries collectively referred to as the "Parties."

1.2. General Allegations

CPA alleges that Beaver Street Fisheries manufactured and distributed and offered for sale in the State of California "Wild Caught Sea Scallops" (UPC# 085239286913) ("Covered Product") containing Cadmium, and that such sales have not included warnings pursuant to the Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986, California Health & Safety Code sections 25249.6 et seq. and its implementing regulations ("Proposition 65"). California has identified and listed Cadmium under Proposition 65 as a chemical known to the State of California to cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm.

1.3. Product Description

The products that are covered by this Settlement Agreement are defined as Wild Caught Sea Scallops (UPC# 085239286913) that Beaver Street Fisheries has manufactured, imported, sold, offered for sale or distributed in California. All such items shall be referred to herein as the "Products."

1.4. Notice of Violation

On 03/30/2024 CPA served Target Brands, Inc., Target Corporation, and the requisite public enforcement agencies eligible to initiate Proposition 65 actions on behalf of the People of the State of California with a document entitled "60-Day Notice of Violation" ("Notice") that provided Beaver Street Fisheries and such public enforcers with notice that Beaver Street Fisheries was allegedly in violation of California Health & Safety Code section 25249.6 for failing to warn consumers and customers that the Products exposed users in California to Cadmium. To the best of the Parties' knowledge, no public enforcer has commenced or is diligently prosecuting the allegations set forth in the Notice.

1.5. No Admission

The Parties enter into this Settlement Agreement to settle disputed claims between them as set forth herein and in the Notice. Beaver Street Fisheries denies the material factual and legal allegations contained in CPA's Notice and maintains that all products that it has manufactured for sale and distribution in California, including the Products, have been and are in compliance with Proposition 65 or any other statutory, regulatory, common law or equitable doctrine. Nothing in this Settlement Agreement shall be construed as an admission by Beaver Street Fisheries of any fact, finding, issue of law, or violation of law; nor shall compliance with this Settlement Agreement constitute or be construed as an admission by Beaver Street Fisheries of any fact, binding, conclusion, issue of law, or violation of law, such being specifically denied by Beaver Street Fisheries on its behalf. However, nothing in this section shall diminish or otherwise affect the obligations, responsibilities, and duties of Beaver Street Fisheries under this Settlement Agreement.

1.6. Effective Date

For purposes of this Settlement Agreement, the term "Effective Date" shall mean the date this Settlement Agreement is fully executed and a fully executed copy is delivered to Beaver Street Fisheries.

2. INJUNCTIVE RELIEF: REFORMULATION AND WARNINGS

As of the Effective Date, Beaver Street Fisheries, at its sole discretion, agrees to (a) cease selling, offering for sale or distributing the Products in California, (b) manufacture, import, or otherwise source for authorized sale in California only Reformulated Products, as defined pursuant to Section 2.1 below, or (c) provide a clear and reasonable Proposition 65 warning on the Products pursuant to Section 2.2 below.

2.1. Reformulation Standards

The Products shall be deemed to comply with Proposition 65 with regard to Cadmium and be exempt from any Proposition 65 warning requirements for Cadmium in the Products if the exposure does not exceed 4.1 micrograms of Cadmium per day as calculated below ("Reformulated Products").

For the Purpose of this Agreement, the amount of Cadmium a person is exposed to form the Covered Product shall be calculated using the following formula: micrograms of Cadmium per gram of product, multiplied by grams of product per serving of the product (using the largest serving size appearing on the product label), multiplied by servings of the product per day (using the largest number of servings in recommended dosage appearing on the product label), which equals micrograms of Cadmium exposure per day.

Products that were supplied or contracted to be supplied to third parties by Beaver Street Fisheries prior to 6 months after the Effective Date shall be deemed exempted from the requirements of this Section 2 and shall be permitted to be sold through as previously manufactured, packaged and labeled.

2.2. Warning Option

Products that do not meet the warning exemption standard set forth in Section 2.1 above shall be accompanied by a warning as described in Section 2.3 below. This warning requirement shall only be required as to Products that are manufactured, distributed, marketed, imported, sold, shipped for sale or offered for sale to consumers by Beaver Street Fisheries in the State of California. No Proposition 65 warning shall be required for any Products that are supplied or contracted to be supplied to third parties by Beaver Street Fisheries prior to 6 months after the Effective Date, and all such Products are hereby deemed to be exempt from Proposition 65 enforcement.

2.3. Warning Language

- 2.3.1. A clear and reasonable exposure Warning must be provided for Covered Product(s) with Violative Daily Exposure Level that Company Distributes into the State of California after the Compliance Date. The Warning shall consist of either the Standard Warning (under 2.3.1. (a)) or the Short-Form Warning (under 2.3.1. (b)).
 - a. Standard Warning. The Standard Warning shall consist of the statement:

WARNING: Consuming this product can expose you to chemicals including Cadmium, which is known to the State of California to cause cancer and birth defects or other reproductive harm. For more information go to www.P65Warnings.ca.gov/food

b. Short-Form Warning. The Short-Form Warning shall consist of the statement:

MARNING: Cancer and Reproductive Harm. - www.P65Warnings.ca.gov/food

The font size of the Short-Form warning must be a minimum of 6 points, and it cannot be smaller than the largest size font used for Consumer Information.

- 2.3.2. Print Warning. Standard Warning or Short-Form Warning provided pursuant to Section 2.3 in print form must:
 - a. contain the word "WARNING:" in all capital letters, in bold font, followed by a colon;
 - b. display the Warning Symbol to the left of the word "WARNING:";
 - c. display the Warning Symbol in a size no smaller than the height of the word "WARNING:";
 - d. be affixed to or printed on the Products' label, or on a placard, shelf tag, sign or electronic device;

- e. be displayed with such conspicuousness, as compared with other words, statements, or designs as to render it likely to be read and understood by an ordinary individual under customary conditions of purchase or use;
- f. be set off from other surrounding information;
- g. be enclosed in a box with a black, bold border.
- 2.3.3. Online/Internet Warning. If Company or a Distributor sell(s) Covered Product via internet websites to customers located in California, the warning requirements of this section shall be satisfied by (1) on-label warning and (2) the Warning also must be displayed online prior to the purchase, either on one or on all of the below:
 - (a) on the same web page on which a Covered Product is displayed and/or described;
 - (b) on the same page as the price for the Covered Product is displayed; or
- (c) on one or more web pages displayed to a purchaser prior to completion of purchase during the checkout process.
- 2.3.4. Online Warning must comply with all requirements of Section 2.3.2 of this Agreement, except 2.3.2.(d).
- 2.3.5. Online Warning must be visible for an ordinary consumer without scrolling a page past Covered Product's image or price. Warning must be displayed next to the Covered Product's image or price, in a manner that clearly associates it with Covered Product(s) to which the Warning applies.
- 2.3.6. Online Short Term Warning, in addition to other requirements, must display a Warning Symbol with the clickable word "WARNING" in bold, black font, in the font size no less than the largest font in the Consumer Information; must link to the text of the Standard Warning; and must link to the website http://www.P65Warnings.ca.gov/food
- **2.4 Foreign Language** If the Product has consumer information in a foreign language, then the package must also contain the WARNING in the foreign language.

3. PENALTIES PURSUANT TO HEALTH & SAFETY CODE SECTION 25249.7(b)

In full satisfaction of all potential civil penalties and attorney's fees, costs and any and all other costs and/or expenses incurred by CPA or its counsel, Beaver Street Fisheries, LLC shall pay the total Settlement amount of Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000) (The "Settlement Amount") as set forth below.

3.1 Civil Penalties to Health & Safety Code 25249.7 (B):

One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars of the Settlement Amount shall be considered a "civil penalty" pursuant to California Health and Safety Code. Beaver Street Fisheries, LLC shall issue two separate checks within ten (10) days of the Effective Date for a total amount of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500) as follows, and all payments shall be delivered to the addresses listed below.

- 3.1 (a) One Check made payable to the State of California's Office of Environmental Health Hazzard Assessment ("OEHHA") in the amount of One Thousand One Hundred Twenty Five Dollars (\$1,125), representing 75% of the total civil penalty; and
- 3.1 (b) One check payable to "Clean Product Advocates, LLC" in the amount of Three Hundred Twenty Five Dollars (\$375), representing 25% of the total civil penalty.

3.2 Attorney's Fees and Costs:

Eighteen Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$18,500) of the total Settlement Amount shall be paid to Cliffwood Law Firm, PC within ten (10) days of the Effective Date, as CPA's attorneys, for reasonable investigation fees, and costs, attorney's fees, and any other cost incurred as a result of investigating and bringing this matter to Beaver Street Fisheries' attention.

4. PAYMENT PROCEDURES

4.1 All Payments owed to OEHHA, pursuant to section 3.1(a) shall be delivered directly to OEHHA (Memo line "Prop 65 Penalties NOV #2024-01303") at the following address:

4.4 PROOF OF PAYMENT

A copy of each check payable to OEHHA, shall be mailed to Cliffwood Law firm, PC, simultaneous with payment to Cliffwood Law Firm, PC at the address set forth above, as proof of payment to OEHHA.

5. RELEASE OF ALL CLAIMS

5.1. Release of Beaver Street Fisheries and Downstream Customers and Upstream Vendors

In further consideration of the promises and agreements herein contained, and for the payments to be made pursuant to Sections 3 and 4 above, CPA, on behalf of itself and its respective owners, principals, shareholders, members, managers, officers, directors, employees, affiliates, parents, subsidiaries, its past and current agents, representatives, attorneys, successors and/or assignees (collectively, "Releasors"), hereby waives all rights to institute or participate in, directly or indirectly, any form of legal action and fully and finally releases all claims relating to the Products, including, without limitation, all actions, and causes of action, in law or in equity, suits, liabilities, demands, obligations, damages, costs, fines, penalties, losses or expenses (including, but not limited to, investigation fees, expert fees and attorneys' fees) of any nature whatsoever, whether known or unknown, fixed or contingent (collectively "Claims"), against (a) Beaver Street Fisheries (b) each of Beaver Street Fisheries' downstream distributors in the stream of commerce, including but not limited to Beaver Street Fisheries and any other upstream or downstream entities in the distribution chain for the Products, including, but not limited to Target Brands, Inc., Target Corporation, and all manufacturers, suppliers, wholesalers, vendors, licensors, licensees, auctioneers, retailers, franchisees, dealers, shareholders, cooperative members, customers, owners, purchasers, third-party re-sellers, and users, (c) each of the foregoing's parent companies, corporate affiliates, subsidiaries, affiliates, doing business as entities ("DBAs"), successor companies, and their respective officers, directors, attorneys, representatives, shareholders, agents, and employees, and sister and parent entities, and (d) the employees, shareholders, officers, directors, members, managers, equity owners, insurers, attorneys, predecessors, successors and assigns of any of the entities identified in subsections (a), (b) and (c), above (the individuals and entities identified in (a)(b)(c) and (d) above are all separately and collectively "Releasees"). CPA also, on behalf of itself, its past and current agents, representatives, attorneys, successors, and/or assignees, provides a general release herein, which shall be effective to the fullest extent permitted by law, as a full and final accord and satisfaction, as a bar to all actions, causes of action, obligations, costs, expenses, attorneys' fees, damages, losses, claims, liabilities and demands of any nature, character or kind, known or unknown, suspected or unsuspected, against Beaver Street Fisheries and the Releasees.

5.2 Beaver Street Fisheries' Release of CPA

Beaver Street Fisheries, on behalf of itself, its past and current agents, representatives, attorneys, successors and/or assignees, hereby waives any and all claims against CPA, her attorneys and other representatives, for any and all actions taken or statements made (or those that could have been taken or made) by CPA and/or her attorneys and other representatives, whether in the course of investigating claims or otherwise seeking to enforce Proposition 65 against it in this matter or with respect to the Products.

5.3 California Civil Code § 1542.

It is possible that other claims not known to the Parties arising out of the facts alleged in the Notice and relating to the Products will develop or be discovered. CPA on behalf of itself only, on one hand, and Beaver Street Fisheries, on the other hand, acknowledge that this Agreement is expressly intended to cover and include all such claims up through the Effective Date, including all rights of action thereof. The Parties acknowledge that the claims released in §§ 5.1 and 5.2, above, may include unknown claims, and nevertheless waive California Civil Code § 1542 as to any such unknown claims. California Civil Code § 1542 reads as follows:

A GENERAL RELEASE DOES NOT EXTEND TO CLAIMS THAT THE CREDITOR OR RELEASING PARTY DOES NOT KNOW OR SUSPECT TO EXIST IN HIS OR HER FAVOR AT THE TIME OF EXECUTING THE RELEASE AND THAT, IF KNOWN BY HIM OR HER, WOULD HAVE MATERIALLY AFFECTED HIS OR HER SETTLEMENT WITH THE DEBTOR OR RELEASED PARTY.

CPA and Beaver Street Fisheries each acknowledge and understand the significance and consequences of this specific waiver of California Civil Code § 1542.

6. **GOVERNING LAW**

The terms of this Settlement Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of California and apply within the State of California. In the event that Proposition 65 is repealed or is otherwise rendered inapplicable by reason of law generally, or as to the Products, then Beaver Street Fisheries shall have no further obligations pursuant to this Settlement Agreement.

7. NOTICES

Unless specified herein, all correspondence and notices required to be provided pursuant to this Settlement Agreement shall be in writing and personally delivered or sent by:
(i) U.S. certified mail, postage prepaid, return receipt requested; or (ii) overnight courier with proof of delivery, on any party by the other party at the following addresses:

8. COUNTERPARTS; FACSIMILE/E-SIGNATURES

This Settlement Agreement may be executed in counterparts and by facsimile or e- signatures, each of which shall be deemed an original, and all of which, when taken together, shall constitute one and the same document.

9. ENTIRE AGREEMENT

This Settlement Agreement contains the sole and entire agreement and understanding of the Parties with respect to the entire subject matter hereof, and all related prior discussions

10. MODIFICATION

This Settlement Agreement may be modified only by a written agreement signed by the Parties.

11. AUTHORIZATION

The undersigned are authorized to execute this Settlement Agreement on behalf of their respective Parties and have read, understood and agree to all of the terms and conditions of this Settlement Agreement.
