

AMENDMENT TO SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

The Parties having entered into a Settlement Agreement as of October 31, 2025, and all payments having been duly made thereunder wish, at the request of the Attorney General's Office, to make a change to the text of the agreeable warning so as to make it consistent with the regulatory safe harbor warning. As such, Paragraph 2.3 of the Settlement Agreement shall now read as follows:

2.3 Text of the Warning.

The Noticed Party shall use one of the warning options set forth below, which shall include a symbol consisting of a black exclamation point in a yellow equilateral triangle with a bold black outline as shown or similar to warning shown below (the symbol may be black or white if the color yellow is otherwise not used on the Product's packaging):

Foreign Language Requirement. Where a product sign, label or shelf tag used to provide a warning includes consumer information in a language other than English, the Warning must also be provided in that language in addition to English.


